

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

**Phase VIII – Module 2 and C-3A Closure Construction  
La Crosse County Landfill**

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the Solid Waste Director at the La Crosse County Solid Waste Office, 6500 State Road 16, La Crosse, Wisconsin 54601 until **1:00 p.m., Thursday, February 1, 2018**, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud. Major Components of the Work include:

1. Phase VIII – Module 2 Liner Construction
  - a. Construction of a composite liner system, including an approximate 4.8-acre composite liner consisting of an HDPE geomembrane and a 4-foot compacted clay layer.
  - b. Perimeter berm and ditch grading.
  - c. Construction of a leachate collection drainage layer with headwell and Schedule 80 PVC leachate collection piping.
2. C-3A Closure Construction
  - a. Construction of an approximate 4.1-acre composite liner system comprised of two feet of compacted clay and an LLDPE geomembrane overlain with a synthetic geo-composite drainage layer.
  - b. Placement of a 2.5-foot general soils rooting zone layer overlain with a 6-inch layer of vegetated soils including tree plantings.
  - c. Installation of downslope drainage piping and a flow diversion structure.
  - d. Installation of four landfill gas extraction wells in 36-inch diameter boreholes, interconnecting gas header piping, and valves.
3. Roadway, Ditch, Fencing and Sedimentation Basin Construction involving modifications to an existing stormwater basin including grading and installation of a water discharge structure.
4. Retrofitting HDPE piping within existing leachate transfer system manholes.

Bids shall be on the forms provided for that purpose and according to the Contract Documents prepared by Short Elliott Hendrickson Inc. (SEH®) dated January 9, 2018.

A **mandatory** pre-Bid conference will be held at **1:00 p.m., Monday, January 22, 2018** at the La Crosse County Landfill Solid Waste Office, 6500 State Road 16, La Crosse, Wisconsin 54601. Those bidding on the project are welcomed to tour the site before and after the meeting. Representatives of Owner and Engineer will be present at the meeting to discuss the Project. Bidders are required to attend and participate in the conference. Engineer will transmit to all prospective Bidders of record such addenda as Engineer considers necessary in response to questions arising at the conference. Oral statements may not be relied upon and will not be binding or legally effective.

Completed Bidders Proof of Responsibility, Document 00 45 17, must be submitted in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders Article 3 prior to the date bids are due. No bids will be accepted from any Bidder for which a Bidders Proof of Responsibility has not been received. The Owner reserves the right to reject the Bid from any Bidder deemed to be unqualified.

No bidder may withdraw their Bid within 60 days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

La Crosse County, Wisconsin reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive irregularities and informalities therein and to award the Contract in the best interests of the County.
